Directions to Comcast Center

From US Route 1:

From the North: Follow US Route 1 South into College Park. Bear Right onto 193 West (University Blvd.) At the first light take a left onto Terrapin Trail. Turn right into Lot 9 and park in any available parking space. Enter Comcast Center from the North Entrance.

From the South: Follow US Route 1 North into College Park. Pass the University of Maryland (Main Campus Entrance) on the Left. Bear right onto 193 West (University Blvd.). At the first light take a left onto Terrapin Trail. Turn right into Lot 9 and park in any available parking space. Enter Comcast Center from the North Entrance.

If Lot 9 is Full: Exit the Parking Lot and turn right onto Terrapin Trail. Pass the softball field and Comcast Center. At the stop sign, turn right. Follow the road approximately 500 feet and turn right into Lot 9 and park in any available parking space. Take the steps up and enter Comcast Center from the South Entrance.

From Distant Points:

From New York City: (Note: these are toll roads, bridges, & tunnels) Take the New Jersey Turnpike South to it's end (about 100 miles) and cross the Delaware Memorial Bridge. Take I-95 South through Delaware (aprox. 20 miles). Once you arrive into Maryland, it's approx 60 miles to Baltimore. As you approach Baltimore, stay on I-95 through the Ft. McHenry Tunnel. After the Tunnel, go about 22 miles South on I-95 and take Exit 27 towards College Park. After a long exit ramp, follow Exit 25B and go South on US Route 1.

From Syracuse, NY and Eastern Pennsylvania: Take I-81 South to Harrisburg, PA, Take I-83 South towards Baltimore. As you approach Baltimore, take I-695 West, the Baltimore Beltway. Take Exit 11 onto I-95 South. Go about 22 miles South on I-95 and take Exit 27 (second lane from the right) towards College Park. After a long exit ramp, follow exit 25B and go South on US Route 1.

From Pittsburg & Western Pennsylvania: Take the Pennsylvania Turnpike (I-76) East and take the Breezewood Exit. Take I-70 South. Go about 60 miles, bypass Hagerstown, MD. At Frederick, MD, take I-270 South towards Washington, DC. After about 30 miles from Frederick, pass Exit 4 and immediately move into your left lane and follow signs for I-495 Washington. Once you are heading East on 495, take Exit 25B and go South on Route 1.

From Morgantown, WV: Take the National Freeway/I-68 East about 100 miles to Hancock, MD. At Hancock, take I-70 South and go about 48 miles to Frederick, MD. At Frederick, take I-270 South towards Washington DC. After about 30 miles from Frederick, pass Exit 4 and immediately move into your left lane and follow signs for I-495 Washington. Once you are heading East on 495, take Exit 25B and go South on Route 1.

From Eastern Tennessee & Southwestern Virginia: Take I-81 North, Take Exit 76 onto I-66 East. Go about 62 miles and take I-495 North towards Baltimore. Within eight miles you'll enter Maryland. Follow I-495 and take Exit 25B South onto US Route 1.

From North Carolina via Richmond, VA: Take I-85 North from Charlotte, Greensboro, or Durham (NC), or I-95 North from Fayetteville or Rocky Mount (NC) to Petersburg, VA. Take/Stay on I-95 North at Petersburg and pass Richmond and Fredericksburg, VA. In about 35 miles you'll come to Springfield, VA where I-495 and I-95 merge. Take I-95/495 East about 8 miles into the state of Maryland. Go about 25 miles and take Exit 25B and go South on Route 1.

From Maryland's Eastern Shore: Take US Route 50 over the Chesapeake Bay Bridge. (there is only an eastbound toll). Once you cross the bridge, follow US Route 50 West for about 25 miles and take I-95 North. Take Exit 25B South onto Route 1
