hab following injuries. They are joined by freshmen Lynetta Kizer, Yemi Oyefuwa, and junior college transfer Dee Liles, who are excited to don the red, black and gold for the Terps!

In addition to Kristi and Marissa, other returning players include fifth-year senior Sa'de Wiley-Gatewood, and sophomores Marah Strickland and Drey Mingo.

Rounding out the squad is Lori Bjork, a graduate student who played for three years at Illinois, but is not permitted to

compete this season.

Another component of the new look for the 08-09 season are Under Armour uniforms the team will wear. Under a new agreement recently signed with the athletics department, Under Armour becomes the official athletic supplier for all 27 of Maryland's teams, creating a distinguishing look for all Terps!

## On the Road Again...

*Terps travel for December matchups!*

Patience is a virtue— and that may well become the mantra for Terp fans, ready to see this team return to the Comcast Center. After creating early season excitement with home wins over Delaware State, James Madison and UCLA, our incredible home court advantage (as well as our home court win streak) is currently on hold and will remain that way until December 29 and the start of the Terrapin Classic. After returning from a three game/three win Thanksgiving tournament in Cancun, the Terps will spend the better part of December traveling to non-conference matchups!

The December road trip gets underway with a trip to the midwest, to take on a talented Purdue squad, in an ACC/Big 10 Challenge matchup. The game, scheduled for December 4 will be televised on the Big Ten Network.

Maryland saw Pitt twice last season, once as an

early season and inexperienced opponent. The Terps won the game 90-77. The second time, a seasoned Pitt team fell to Stanford 53-72 in a Sweet 16 matchup in Spokane as the Maryland team looked on. (I said they saw them twice, I didn't say they played them twice!) Maryland meets Pitt for a return game this season, in Pittsburgh, Sunday, December 7 at 2:00pm.

The road trip continues on Tuesday, December 9 with a quick bus ride up I-95 north for a meeting with Loyola. Previous matchups, have featured Terp fans overwhelming the Greyhounds 3000 seat, Reitz arena, creating a "home away from home" game feel.

The conclusion of the December road trip features a matchup with storied program Old Dominion. This club has loaded their non-conference sched-

ules with powerhouses; Texas, Virginia and Tennessee. They will be ready for the challenge of the Terrapins on Sunday, December 21 at 2:00pm.
